Council Grants Open

Community groups, clubs, and not for profit organisations in the Mildura Rural City Council area can apply for grants in three categories:

1. Community Grants: Up to \$10,000 for significant projects and up to \$6,000 for smaller projects that enhance local community life. Applications close on August 19, 2024.
2. Recreation Assistance Grants: Funding available for facility upgrades (major and minor), recreation planning projects, and club support grants. Applications close in March 2025.
3. Waste Minimisation & Resource Recovery Grants: Open to businesses with ABNs and incorporated groups.
